#### OPENING SCENE - HUGH'S INTRODUCTION

Hugh Merrit is a newly released parolee who is attempting to maintain a crime-free lifestyle. He is rushing to get ready this morning as he is running late for his parole meeting. At this meeting, his phone is confiscated and searched to ensure that he is obeying the guidelines of his no-contact order.

After the meeting, he is reprimanded by his boss for his lack of communication and tardiness. His boss, Marco lets Hugh know that his next strike will be his last.

### THE FIRST CONTACT

After a bad day, Hugh creates a fake account on Facebook and sends a friend request to Katrina Jefferies, one of his victims. Katrina, 17, is ecstatic.
